Through employment, we earn a living, build high self-esteem and increase participation in the community.

United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific reports that approximately 650 million persons with disabilities live in Asia and the Pacific. This number is expected to rise over the next decades due to population aging, natural disasters, and other factors. Most live in poverty and have less economic participation. Jobs and employment are one of the best means of overcoming poverty. Workability Asia aims to promote the Incheon Strategy to "Make the Right Real" for persons with disabilities in Asia and the Pacific.
